* **Bridge Course** - One month Yoga Instructors Course (YIC) is compulsory for all long term courses.

Eligibility Marks

1. For UG course General/OBC candidates should have 50% marks at 10+2 level. This is relaxed to 40 % marks for SC/ST/sports/J&K candidates.
2. For PG courses General/OBC candidates should have 50% marks at UG level. This is relaxed to 45 % marks for SC/ST/Sports/J&K candidates.

Steps in Admission Process for Students to follow

1. Notification - with intake capacity and date of entrance examination.
2. Online application for long term courses at [S-VYASA Admissions](#)
3. Submission of scanned copies of all required original documents to admissions@svyasa.org
4. Reporting for entrance examination as per the schedule.

5. Payment of fees
 - a. DD in favour of "SVYASA" payable at Bangalore
 - b. Net-banking / deposit in university account.
 - c. Direct Payment card in campus.

Note : Cash Payment not accepted.

Documents required for all Programs

14. Physically disabled certificate in case of physically challenged candidates

* For PG programs (Any Graduation certificate, Migration certificate)

* For MD(Y&R), it is mandatory for the candidate to produce medical degree certificate from a recognized University.

* PhD -Any master programs certificate.

Reservation Guidelines for Universities

Reservation of seats for SC, ST, OBC, SBC, Physically handicapped and University employee's spouse.

- a. Total 50 % of seats in each program shall be reserved for natural born sons/daughters of parents belonging to Scheduled Castes (15 %), Scheduled Tribes (6 %), Other Backward Classes (25 %) excluding those who fail within category of creamy layer) and special backward classes (1%). [See notification dated 29.06.10 No. Acad II / MDSU / 2010 / 20571) on producing required certificates.

- b. Physically handicapped 2%, Ex servicemen (1%).
- c. Sports quota - 8 seats
- d. Jammu and Kashmir candidates - 2 seats.

Overall 33.33 % seats will be reserved for women candidates. Super numeral seats in each program run by the University teaching departments shall be reserved for the University employee's Spouse/ son or daughter. These additional seats will be in addition to the total number of seats allotted in that particular program. The admission under this reserved category will be made on the basis of merit of applicants under this category.
